**UKNSCN INTERIM BULLETIN - FCO UK-US STEM CELL COLLABORATION DEVELOPMENT AWARDS (REMINDER)**

As indicated in the UKNSCN's August e-bulletin (No.10), the UK's Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) has recently announced a second round of funding for its UK-US stem cell collaboration development awards. The scheme is open to UK- or US-based stem cell researchers only, who are at group leader or Principal Investigator level within academic or non-profit research institutions. Up to £5,000 (approximately \$10,000) is available for travel from the applicant's home country to either the US or the UK. You are reminded that the closing date for applications to the second round is **14 September 2008** (next Sunday).
