UKNSCN INTERIM BULLETIN - UKNSCN 2010 CONFERENCE, NOTTINGHAM, 12-14 JULY: ON-LINE REGISTRATION AND CONFERENCE PROGRAMME NOW AVAILABLE

UKNSCN is delighted to announce that on-line registration for the UK's third annual stem cell science meeting is now open via the UKNSCN website at the link below. Up to 520 delegate places are available, together with space for up to 40 exhibition stands and 150 posters. The conference programme is also now published via the link below. Please note that registration is open to delegates from overseas.

UKNSCN is continuing with its policy of providing on-site accommodation where it is needed (included in the registration fee) and keeping registration fees low in order to encourage the maximum possible participation from UK-based PhD students and post-doctoral researchers, as well as senior Principal Investigators. Registration fees therefore range from a maximum of £271 for standard delegates requiring two nights' ensuite accommodation down to £83 for a UK-based PhD student who presents a poster and does not require accommodation to be provided.
